



Scholarship Application Form For the 2011-2012 Academic Year

- Award recipient must be a son, daughter, or grandchild of an active Boston Chapter Member.
- Local membership dues must be paid by February 2011 to qualify as an active member.
- Recipient must be planning on attending or currently attending in a two-year or four-year undergraduate degree at an accredited institution. Priority preference will be given to students that concentrate in finance, business or accounting studies, however, any major will be given consideration.
- A minimum GPA of 3.0 or better at current institution of learning, including high school.
- Awarded scholarship check will be payable in the name of the student and the FMS Chapter member upon receipt of commitment letter copy. The \$1,000 scholarship may be used to pay for college tuition, books and/or fees. Please limit submissions to one submission per member per year.
